MAJOR PIPELINE PROJECTS

CONVENTION CENTER EXPANSION & 650 ROOM HOTEL

- Addition of 247,000 SF of space will more than double the existing convention center's footprint
- New ballrooms, exhibit halls and more
- New 673,000 SF convention hotel coming Summer 2027
- Spa, fitness center and three signature restaurants

ARENA ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT

- New pedestrian and entertainment-oriented development
- New luxury hotel
- 70,000 square feet of new commercial space and
- 700 new luxury apartments
- Future phases include a performance arts theatre and a California Sports Hall of Fame.

NEW 200-ACRE REGIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX

- 6,000 seat Minor League Baseball stadium
- 187,000 SF, 290-room dual brand hotel (site plan)
- 180,000 SF of retail, restaurants, bars & entertainment
- State-of-the-art sports facilities and fields
- Will attract 1.2 million new visitors annually
