EXPANSION HIGHLIGHTS

- Addition of 247,000 SF of space to 222,560 SF footprint nearly doubling the usable space for exhibit, meeting, and ballroom spaces
- Improved capability for simultaneous events

- New 673,000 SF convention hotel - Completion: Summer 2027
 - 600+ rooms

DOWNTOWN

- Revitalization of Historic core with modern affordable housing, adaptive reuse of historic structures, mixed use development, and new business opportunities.
- 600 new residential units
- 13,000 square feet of new commercial space
- New University of La Verne College of Health and Randall Lewis Center of Innovation, Social Impact, and Entrepreneurship C

ARENA ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT

- New pedestrian and entertainment-oriented development
- New luxury hotel
- 70,000 square feet of new commercial space and
- 700 new luxury apartments
- Future phases include a performance arts theatre and a California Sports Hall of Fame.

NEW 200-ACRE REGIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX

- 6,000 seat Minor League Baseball stadium
- 187,000 SF, 290-room dual brand hotel (site plan)
